2022 DBREC Policy Priorities



Career Pathways

Sustain state investment in expanding training programs and apprenticeships

Streamline and improve communication of scholarships and incentive funds



Fair & Efficient Funding

Increase funding equity through a second, mid-year student count, which will provide funding for students who enroll or are identified as having special needs after September 30.



Early Learning

Increase state investment in child care subsidy (Purchase of Care) to reach the national best practice of the 75th percentile of the market rate.

Reduce the adult:child (“unit”) ratio in special education Pre-K to ensure pre-K is in line with Delaware K-12 ratios and national best practice.



Educators

Fund teacher residencies and Grow Your Own initiatives to diversify and grow the teaching workforce, leveraging \$4 million agreed upon in lawsuit settlement
